which will be held at the Ice Rink Piné in Baselga di Piné, Trentino, Italy on November 25-26, 2023

The Competition will be held under the 2022 ISU General Regulations, Special Regulations & Technical Rules for Speed Skating and ISU Communication No. 2572.

Quartet starts will be used in the 3000m (it may also be used for 1000 and 1500m) according to ISU Communication No. 2572, paragraph 5.1).

TRACK

A standard speed skating track of 400 meters to the lap laid out at Ice Rink Piné, an artificially frozen outdoor skating rink in Baselga di Piné – Trentino. The radii of the inner and outer competition lanes are 25 and 29 meters, respectively. The width of the inside training lane is 4 meters.

ENTRIES

Entries for this competition will be restricted and must be made according to ISU Regulations and ISU Communication No. 2572, paragraph 4.

As per ISU Rule 108, participation in the **Juniors division** is open to:

• Juniors A and B born in the period 1 July 2004 – 30 June 2008

Participation in the **Neo-Seniors division** is open to:

• **Skaters** born in the period 1 July 2000 – 30 June 2004

Entries can only be made using the ISU Online Entry System for Speed Skating Events on https://ssk-entries.isu.org/ and respecting the following deadlines:

Preliminary entries, giving the estimated number of Competitors and the number of coaches and other team staff, as well as provisional names of the Competitors and Team leader must be communicated at the latest *by October 23, 2023*.

Final entries including the names of the Competitors and available substitutes, as well as the names of the Team leader, coaches and other team staff for whom an accreditation is required must reach the Organizing Committee at the latest by 12:00 noon (local time) on November 20, 2023.

Please note that for all persons entered by the ISU Members, the procedures regarding the Declaration for Competitors and Officials (all team officials requiring an accreditation) entering ISU Events (Rule 131) as outlined in ISU Communication No. 1628, need to be strictly observed.

For more details please refer to Rules 115, 131 and ISU Communications No. 1628 and 1797 or any update of this Communication.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU Regulations and ISU Communication No. 2526, all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the ISU Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another ISU Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate.

ENTRY QUOTAS

An ISU Member¹ may enter a maximum of 10 Competitors per category (10 Women and 10 Men). Subject to the qualifying times criteria listed below, maximum 4 Competitors for 500 and 1000m, maximum 3 Competitors for 1500 and 3000m and maximum 2 Competitors for Mass Start may be entered for each individual event in each Division (Juniors & Neo-seniors).

For the Team Pursuit event, an ISU Member may enter a maximum of one team per gender in each division. Up to two (2) Junior Skaters may take part in a team event in the Neo-senior Division but not vice versa.

QUALIFYING TIMES

Entered Skaters (including substitutes) must have achieved applicable qualifying times for the respective distances, as listed in ISU Communication No. 2572, paragraph 4.3:

For a result to be valid as a qualifying time, it must have been achieved in the period between July 1, 2022, and the entry deadline for the ISU Junior World Cup Competition concerned. Documentation (specifying date and venue of the competition) of the achieved time must be available.

MASS START RACES

Mass Start races will be organized in accordance with Rule 243, paragraph 4, Rule 257 and Rule 265, paragraph 6.1 and 6.4 and ISU Communication No. 2584 (or any further update).

TEAM PURSUIT RACES

Team Pursuit races will be skated according to Rule 256, paragraph 1, Rule 265, paragraph 5 and ISU Communication No. 2584 (or any further update), with national teams of 3 Skaters each, and with distances of 6 laps for Women and 8 laps for Men.

GROUPING AND DRAWING PROCEDURES

The grouping and drawing of pairs will be according to ISU Communication No. 2572, paragraph 6.

POINTS

For each distance Junior World Cup points will be awarded according to ISU Communication No. 2572, paragraph 7.2.

PRIZES

Prizes will be presented to the three (3) best Skaters in each event (distance) in each Division. Junior World Cup points gained will count towards the final ISU Junior World Cup ranking 2023/24.

ANTI-DOPING

Anti-Doping tests will be carried out in accordance with the valid ISU Anti-Doping Rules and ISU Anti-Doping Procedures (ISU Communications No. 2344 & 2366 or any further update of these Communications).

TRAINING TIMES

The speed skating track will be open for training for entered Competitors from Wednesday, November 22, 2023 from 09.00 am to 11.00 am and from 05.00 pm to 07.00 pm. Trial starts will be organized on Friday, November 24, 2023 from 10:00 am to 11:00 am.

Only accredited Competitors, substitutes and team officials will be allowed to enter the ice-rink during the official training hours.

LIABILITY

In accordance with Rule 119 of the ISU General Regulations, the ISU, Italian Sport Ice Federation and the Organizing Committee assume no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property loss or damage incurred in connection with the ISU Junior World Cup Speed Skating. Each Member is solely responsible for providing insurance coverage thereto.

ACCOMMODATION

Participating ISU Members will have to bear expenses for accommodation for all participating Skaters and team officials.

The cost of a room and meal at the official hotel(s) will be as follows:

Single Room occupancy: 135,00 € per room per night. Price including meals and soft drinks.

Double Room occupancy: 176,00 € per room per night (€ 88,00/person). Price including meals and soft drinks.

Triple Room occupancy: 240,00 € per room per night (€ 80,00/person). Price including meals and soft drinks.

Further to the price indicated above, for each kind of room and for each hotel, a required by law tourist tax of 2€/person/night must be paid cash directly at the hotel upon arrival.

Cancellation policy:

- no penalty up to 30 days before the beginning of the stay (Oct. 23, 2023)
- 25% from 29 to 21 days before the beginning of the stay (Oct. 24-27 2023)
- 50% from 20 to 11 days before the beginning of the stay (Oct. 28-Nov. 9, 2023)
- 75% from 10 to 4 days before the beginning of the stay (Nov. 10-16, 2023)
- No reimbursement from Nov. 17, 2023 on.

Guests name change will be accepted until check-in if no modification on the allocation of rooms and/or total cost apply.

Payment: with credit card at confirmation of the reservation. No check-in without payment.

Entries can only be made using the ISU Online Entry System for Speed Skating Events.

OFFICIAL HOTEL(S)

The Organizing Committee entrusted as incoming agency the Official Tourism Board - APT Trento - for hotel reservation. The requests must be sent within October 23, 2023 at the following link:

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to limit the number of hotel rooms available to each team at the official hotel(s). The organizer is not obliged to provide services (accommodation, accredited entrance to the ice rink, transportation, etc.) for an excessive number of team officials or other accompanying persons from participating ISU Members. Names and functions of all team officials must be submitted together with the final entries for the competition.

TRANSPORTATION

The Organizing Committee would like to be informed via the ISU Online Entry System about the time of arrival and departure (incl. flight details) of the competitors and team officials as soon as possible, but not later than November 6, 2023.

The transfer from any of the main airports of Northern Italy to Baselga di Piné with public transport is not direct. You can ask for the price and organize your transfer with the agency Trentino Holidays at the following link, filling in the form:

The Organizing Committee will provide free of charge transportation between the official hotel(s) and the ice rink from Wednesday November 22, 2023 until the Competition is finished. Further transportation can be organized upon request and at own costs.
